1. Claustrophobia



Definition : an extreme fear of being in a small confined place; the unpleasant feeling that a person gets in a situation which restricts them

Usage: I have felt a terrible claustrophobia in a small theatre

2. Beatitude- பேரின்துபுட or supreme blessed

Definition: (in the Bible) the eight statements made by Christ about people who are blessed

2) Supreme blessedness or happiness.

Usage: A beatitude child will be more blessed.

3. Niggardly- கஞ்சத்தனம் or



Definition: unwilling to be generous with money, time, etc. | not worth much and given unwillingly

Usage: He was such a niggard that he would not pay for his daughter's medicine

4. Extrovert



Definition: a lively and confident person who enjoys being with other people

Usage: Their relationship didn't work out because he was an extrovert who hated to be alone and she was an introvert who preferred to be alone.

5. Affiliate- officially attach or connect

Definition: a company, an organization, etc. that is connected with or controlled by another larger one Usage: our local Humane Society is an affiliate of a national organization

6.Sacrilegious- அவமதிப்பாகவும்/sinful

Definition: Grossly irreverent toward what is or is held to be sacred. | an act of treating a holy thing or place without respect

Usage: Everyone glared at him for being so sacrilegious as to swear in church.

7. Putrid- அசுத்த,, அழுகிய, unpleasent smell

Definition: decaying and therefore smelling very bad | very unpleasant
Usage : " a putrid dark colour"

8.Campaign- பிரச்சாரம்



Definition: 1) a series of planned activities that are intended to achieve a particular social, commercial, or political aim
2) a series of attacks and battles that are intended to achieve a particular military aim during a war

Usage: A new campaign has begun to encourage more people to become blood donors.

9.Depict- சித்தரிக்க, describe

Definition to show an image of someone or something in a picture

2) to describe something in words, or give an impression of something in words or with a picture

Usage A gallery of pictures depicting famous battles

10.Carnage



Definition: the violent killing of a large number of people

Usage : There was much carnage on the battlefield.

11.Scanty



Definition: too little in amount for what is needed | very small and not covering much of your body

Usage : The scanty amount of food on the table was barely enough for the whole family.

12.Colander



Definition: a metal or plastic bowl with a lot of small holes in it, used for draining water from vegetables, etc. after washing or cooking

Usage: They will drain the pasta in the metal colander.

13.Credibility

Definition: the quality that someone or something has that makes people believe or trust them

Usage: Jack's credibility was good so he was able to get a loan

14, Acumen- good decision/ judgement



Definition: the ability to understand and decide things quickly and well

Usage: Daniel approached the issues with great acumen.

Definition: calm and peaceful

Usage: a serene smile

16. Discrimination



Definition: the practice of treating someone or a particular group in society less fairly than others

Usage: The restaurant owner was accused of discrimination when he refused to serve some customers.

17. Bicameral



Definition: having two main parts, such as the Senate and the House of Representatives in the U.S. Congress

Usage: Their government is based on bicameralism

18. Amphibious



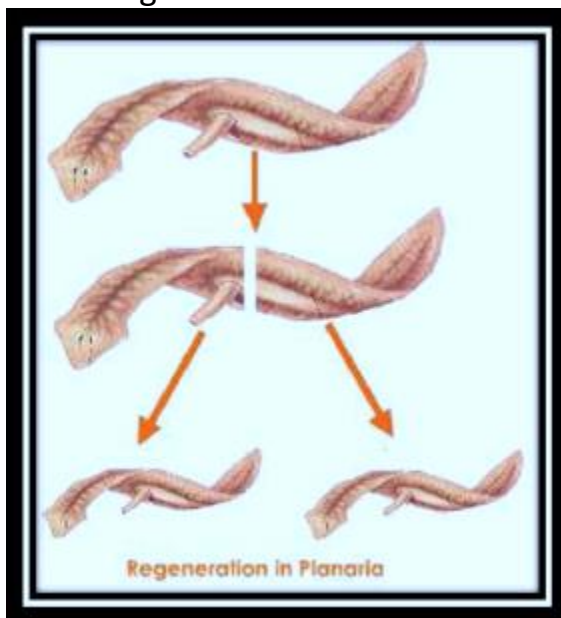

Usage: Amphibious vehicles

19. Resurgence



Definition: the return and growth of an activity that had stopped

Usage: The political party had a resurgence in the 1990's.

20. Gust

Definition: a sudden strong increase in the amount and speed of wind that is blowing | a sudden strong expression of emotion

Usage : A gust of laughter greeted him as he walked into the room.

21.Akin

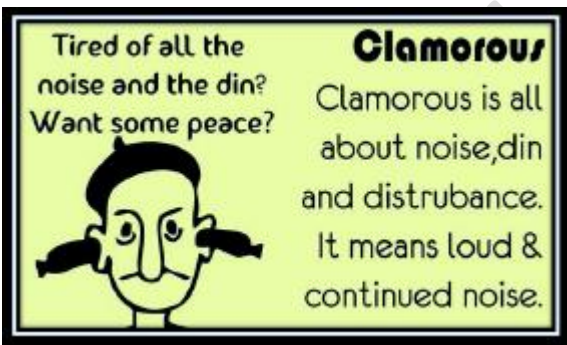


LONGAN FRUIT. RELATED TO THE LYCHEE FRUIT.

Definition: similar or related to

Usage: Foxes are closely akin to dogs

22.Clamor



Definition: to demand something loudly

Usage: There was quite a clamor when the travelers returned home.

23.Cynosure



Definition: a person or thing that is the center of attention

Usage: The wonderful singer became the cynosure of all of the people on the plaza.

24.Jubilation



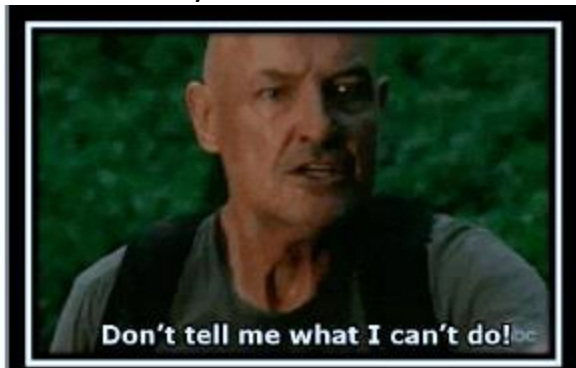
Definition: a feeling of great happiness because of a success

Usage: His resignation was greeted by jubilation on the streets of Sofia.

25.Autonomy



Definition: the freedom for a country, a region, or an organization to govern itself independently

Usage : The territory has been granted autonomy

26.Condiment



Definition: a sauce, etc. that is used to give flavor to food, or that is eaten with food

Usage : The cafeteria's self-serve table has a full array of condiments

27.Brace

Definition: to prepare someone/yourself for something difficult or unpleasant that is going to happen

Usage: The lights showed the old timbers used to brace the roof.

28.Noxious



Definition: poisonous or harmful

Usage: Noxious fumes came from upstairs and effected everyone in the building

29.Repugnant- முரண்படுகின்ற

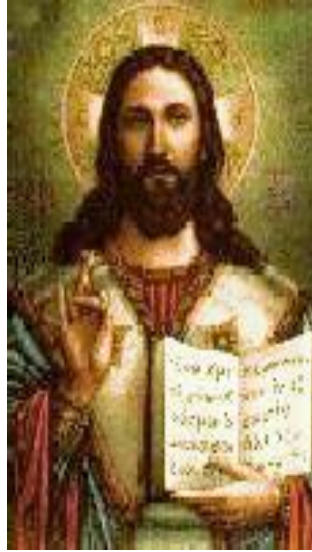

Definition: making you feel strong dislike or disgust

Usage: The entertainment-based rhetoric with which audience of television channels are fed is repugnant to the sensitive.

30. Bias- கோடல், ஒருபக்கம் சாய்தல்



Definition: to unfairly influence someone's opinions or decisions

2) to have an effect on the results of research or an experiment so that they do not show the real situation

Usage : The ruling party biased the electorate with false empathy for the common man
